WHO WE TREAT

We provide care for adults 18 and older who may be experiencing:

- Suicidal thoughts or recent suicide attempts
- Psychosis related to substance use or mental health conditions
- Eating disorders, including anorexia nervosa, bulimia nervosa, binge eating disorder, avoidant/restrictive food intake disorder (ARFID), and other specified feeding or eating disorders (OSFED)
- Active duty military experiencing an eating disorder
- Obsessive-compulsive behaviors
- Non-suicidal self-injury
- Complex cases of depression, anxiety, or bipolar disorder
- Recent manic episodes
- Medication changes requiring close observation
- Trauma or other deeply rooted mental health concerns
